1. Background

The sub-grant entitled "Capacity Building on Total Sanitation and Behavioral Change to Schools, Communities and Local Stakeholders in Bardiya" was implemented in 16 VDCs of Bardiya district covering 127 schools. The grant is designed to support the declaration of D-WASH-CC Bardiya to declare the district open defecation free (ODF) by 2015. RSN/SMID received financial and technical support from UN-Habitat under Global Sanitation Fund (GSF) to implement this sub-grant. The Contract Agreement between RSN and UN Habitat came into effective from 6 June 2012 to 5 December 2013.

The project has targeted to fulfill the sanitation and hygiene gaps in Bardiya by mobilizing the capacitated human resource to sensitize communities for safe disposal of excreta and to adopt proper hygiene and sanitation behaviors. The main objective of this project is to sustain sanitation promotion by developing large number of trained human resources available at local levels who are capacitated through orientations and trainings irrespective of gender, social and educational status with representation from every section of the society.

RSN/SMID had collected GPS information of all the 262 (135 of SGL 4 and 127 of SGL 9) project schools with an aim to contribute GSF programme linking it with disaster management/preparedness programme and increase the access of stakeholders to the school sanitation and hygiene promotional activities. The GPS measurement and GIS based maps and website development with WASH related information is the RSN contribution for SGL-9 sub-grant. Till the end of November 2013, the mobilization activities organized by schools were collected along with the GPS information. These data are updated in the website that would assist the stakeholders to assess the status and results of SGL-9 using internet.

2. Activities

The following activities were carried out during July 2013 to the end of November 2013 to update school level WASH activities.

- i. Prepared data collection plan and data collection form.
- ii. Mobilized field staffs to collect information along with other regular activities.
- iii. Entered accumulated data and provided to RSN headquarter for the update of school sanitation activities in website.

3. Progress

In the final semi-annual period, 385 different inter-school and community focused sanitation promotion activities were organized by 41 schools. In the website, all the 1,096 activities carried out by 127 school including the activities of final semi-annual period are updated.

The details of the activities are in the Annex 1: Activities carried Out by Schools, and the entries are found in RSN website.

4. Content of the Website and GIS Information

The content of the web information covers the following:

- 1. Name and location of the schools,
- 2. GPS Readings of the schools (longitude, latitude, altitude and area)
- 3. Number of students by sex.
- 4. Number of Child Club (girls, boys, DAG)
- 5. Information on toilets and urinals
- 6. Grading of school's overall sanitation status (good, fair and poor)
- 7. Availability of water supply facilities, and
- 8. Activities carried out by schools

5. Activities Organized by Schools

There are 667 different activities organized by 127school during the period of eight months to promote sanitation of school and community during the whole project period. In general, such activities fall under the following two categories:

1. Inter-school activities

After the orientations and trainings, the schools had prepared sanitation plan of action and accelerated school focused sanitation activities. Sanitation plan of action, work division, sanitation rules and regulations, cleaning of classrooms, school premises and toilets, plantation and gardening, poem/essay/art/song competitions, etc. are the major inter-school activities. The child clubs have been publishing wall magazines with support of their focal teachers. In total schools and child clubs had organized 478 different inter-school activities in order to sensitize school students. The students were the main beneficiaries of these activities and teachers and child club members had facilitated/organized these activities. The below table 5.1 shows the summary of school focused sanitation activities.

2. Community focused activities

Regarding the community focused activities, from April 2013 to the end of November 2013, the schools had organized 189 various activities like hand washing demonstration in community, cleaning campaign in community, street drama, sanitation promotion rallies, door-to-door visit campaign, monitoring of toilets and data collection of toilets. There was involvement of HMs, Teachers, child clubs, SMC, PTA, FCHV, Civil Society and trained other local loose networks in the community-focused sanitation activities.
